These buttons allow you to perform the following actions:

Check: allows you to check your answers

Try again: resets the wrong answers, giving you the opportunity to correct them.

Show: shows you the right answers – it becomes active after you have checked your answers.

Reset: removes all answers and re-starts the activity.

Book*: opens a pop-up window with the theory you need to completely the exercise successfully.

Owl*: opens a pop-up window with flash cards that have pictures and examples of the phenomenon being practiced in the exercise.

Important: The teacher can see how many attempts it took you to complete the exercise.

Listening exercises also have the button 'audioscript' at the bottom of the screen. This will open a transcript of the recording and is activated after you have checked your answers.
